a. Minutes review from previous meeting – 16 December

Agenda Item 2: Principal's Update

Presented by Ms. Jennifer Gamble

a. Parent University

- Younger children can be dropped off at Sasebo Elementary School, where dinner will be provided.
- EJ King School will host both Parent University sessions and the Career & Technical Education (CTE) Fair. Dinner will also be available at this site.

Objectives:

- To educate parents about the diverse educational pathways available to students.
- To highlight opportunities for academic and career preparation.
- Teachers and community partners will serve as presenters and hosts of informational sessions and booths.
- Several community organizations will also participate by sharing resources and services available to families.

b. Student Feedback Initiative – February 11, 2026

- A student feedback form was distributed during school hours to gather input on school culture and student well-being.
- Participation was strong, with a high response rate across grade levels.

Preliminary results:

- 70% of students reported having at least one trusted adult in the school community.
- Student Planner Usage: Ms. Gamble conducted a random spot check among middle school students and found that most students are actively utilizing their planners. She plans to extend the spot check to high school students next.
- **Usage of Locker Concerns:** Ms. Barnhart suggested opening the gym area to allow students to drop off their musical instruments and sports equipment in the music room to reduce clutter and improve convenience.

- Some members discussed the potential benefit of introducing a 10-minute break between 2nd and 3rd periods to help students refresh and transition between classes more effectively.

While the major schedule cannot currently be modified, this suggestion will be taken under consideration for future planning.

Bi Literacy Program

This program will be spearheaded by Mr. O'Mara and Mrs. Marti

- The Seal of Biliteracy program recognizes graduating seniors who have achieved proficiency in two or more languages.
- Eligibility Requirements:
 - English Language Arts (ELA): SAT score of 600 or higher
 - World Language: Achievement of Level 5 on the STAMP Test
 - Multilingual Learners (MLL): Score between 4.8 and 5.0
- Recognition: Students who meet these standards will receive a Seal of Biliteracy on their diploma.
- Additional information will be shared with families during Parent University.
